## Bracelet Size Guide

### 🖨️ How to set up your printer

1. Use US Letter paper (8.5" × 11").
2. In your print settings, select **actual size** (100%).
3. Make sure "**scale to fit**" is **unchecked**.
4. After printing, place a standard credit card along the test line to confirm the scale is correct. If the edges align, you're all set.



### Method 1: Measure Your Wrist with a Measuring Tape

1. Use a flexible measuring tape.
2. Wrap it around your wrist, just above the wrist bone, with your palm facing up (where you would normally wear a bracelet).
3. Note the number where the tape overlaps — this is your wrist size.

### Method 2: Measure Your Wrist with a String or Paper Strip

1. Wrap a string or strip of paper around your wrist at the same point.
2. Mark where the ends meet with a pen.
3. Lay the string flat and measure its length with a ruler.



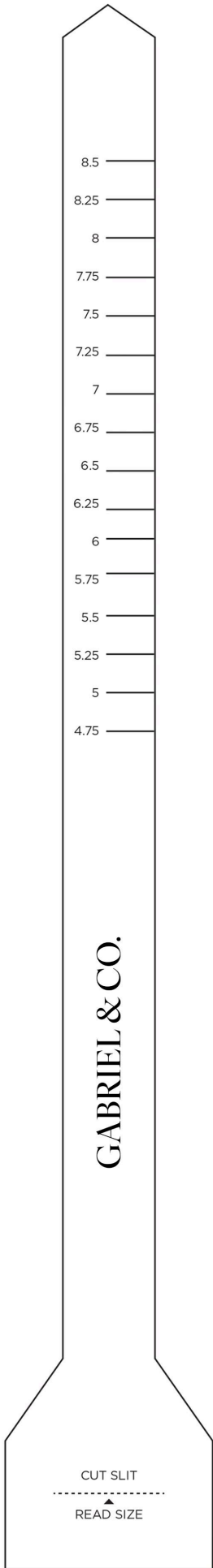
### Method 3: Measure Your Wrist with Sizer

1. Carefully cut along the outline of the printable bracelet sizer. Make a small slit on the dotted line on the left end of the sizer.
2. Wrap the sizer around your wrist just above your wrist bone with the numbers facing out.
3. Pull the pointed end of the sizer through the slit. Tighten it to a comfortable fit around your wrist, as tight or loose as you like.
4. Find your measurement on the sizer. Compare this measurement to the chart below to find your bracelet size. If you are between sizes, opt for the larger size.

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## Fit Preference by Model Type

Bracelet fit can vary depending on style and comfort.

### Choose your fit style:

**Slim fit:** For a closer, more tailored feel, subtract 0.25 inches from your exact bracelet size







**Example:** If your bracelet size is 6 inches, your slim fit bracelet size is 5.75 inches.

**Relaxed fit:** For a more comfortable, easy-to-wear feel, choose a bracelet size that matches yours exactly.

**Example:** If your bracelet is 6 inches, your relaxed fit bracelet size is 6 inches.

The table includes different bracelet models and variations, showing how each style fits in slim and relaxed options based on your bracelet measurement.

 <p>Double-row or multi-row open beaded bracelets (excluding single-thread multi-wrap styles)</p>	Use your exact bracelet size	Add 0.25 inches to your exact bracelet size.
 <p>Open bracelets with stainless steel plates (e.g., Demure style)</p>	Use your exact bracelet size	Add 0.25 inches to your exact bracelet size.
 <p>Rigid bracelets (including rigid hinged, rigid open, and rigid closed styles)</p>	Use your exact bracelet size	Add 0.25 inches to your exact bracelet size.
 <p>Bracelets with 6mm stone/metal beads</p>	Add 0.75 inches to your exact bracelet size.	Add 1 inches to your exact bracelet size.
